1 Babich Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc	7.9	10.5	29.9
<i>Marlborough, New Zealand</i> A classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc which is consistently produced in a fuller, riper, softer style that develops well. Clean, fresh and tropical, with fruit from several vineyards situated throughout Marlborough.			
2 Vinkara Narice	7.7	10.2	28.9
<i>Anatolia, Turkey</i> Turkish white with ripe touches of apricot and citrus. Narince is grown up in the hills one hour north of Ankara close to the Iris river where the Black Sea and the continental hinterland both have an influence on the climate.			
3 Promised Land Unwooded Chardonnay	7.6	9.5	27.9
<i>Clare Valley, Australia</i> The tropical fruit flavours of pure chardonnay without the influence of oak. The palate is silky and the finish is clean and refreshing.			
4 San Giorgio Pinot Grigio DOC	6.4	8.3	22.9
<i>Venezie, Italy</i> Award winning Pinot Grigio which actually delivers and is crafted for us by the now famous Pasqua family. Clean, crisp with loads of flavour all the way from venezie.			
5 Parlez Vous Sauvignon Blanc	5.9	7.5	20
<i>France</i> Very expressive with floral, vegetal and boxwood notes developing into exotic fruits, well-balanced with an expressive finish.

<i>Chablis, France</i> Fantastic purity and minerality with notes of apples, grilled nuts and honey. This is classic, balanced and delicious with taut acidity.	

8 Gavi di Gavi DOCG "Terre Antiche" La Giustiniana	35.9
<i>Piemonte, Italy</i> This wine has an attractive lemon yellow colour. It is scented and delicate, with hints of lime zest on the nose and fruit with a lovely zip and verve on the palate alongside a mineral finish.	

9 Alma Atlántica, `Alba Martín` Rías Baixas Albariño	33.9
<i>Rias Biexas, Spain</i> Elegant aromas of white flowers and white peach, pear, apricot and citrus. A full-bodied and juicy palate is dominated by ripe but delicate tropical fruits and beautifully balanced acidity.

11 Vinkara, Öküzgözü	7.7	9.9	28
<i>Anatolia, Turkey</i> A well balanced, rich wine with lush fruit flavours of boysenberry and blackberry, along with vibrant acidity. Stays pure and focused, with suave toast, mineral and spice notes on the fruit-filled finish.			

12 Tempus Two Merlot	6.8	8.8	24.9
<i>South Eastern Australia</i> A rich and soft smooth wine with dark berries with plum fruit characters, packed with ripe raspberry notes, fine grained tannins and subtle hints of oak.			

13 San Giorgio Montepulciano D'Abruzzo	6.4	8.1	22.9
<i>Italy</i> Easy drinking medium-bodied red with lots of black cherries, bramble fruits, herbs and violets.			

14 The Landings Shiraz Cabernet	5.6	7.2	20
<i>South Eastern Australia</i> Two grape varieties which were made for each other with the Cab delivering back bone and cassis fruit while the Shiraz throws in bags of sweet plummy notes and a tantalising hint of spice.			

15 Le Havre de Paix Rouge	17.9
<i>Cotes de Gascogne, France</i> Beautiful aromas dominated by notes of red fruit, delivering a light, velvety red with hints of plum, red fruit and spicy notes

16 Châteauneuf du Pape - Victor Berard	45
<i>Rhône Valley, France</i> Wonderfully dark in colour, this wine is expressive and complex. Dark fruits are overlaid with spice and liquorice then some aromas of garrigue and finally by woody undertones.	

17 Verum Pinot Noir	38
<i>Patagonia, Argentina</i> Verum means true and Verum Pinot Noir is true to the terroir of Patagonia. Elegant, pure ripe cherry and redcurrant fruit with earthy notes and fine tannins.	

18 Gouguenheim Reserve Malbec, Mendoza	33
<i>Mendoza, Argentina</i> Deep purple in colour with aromas of red fruits, chocolate and coffee beans. Red and black cherry flavours with scents of violets. 8 months in a combination of new and third year barrels gives added warmth and depth to the wine. Smooth with some complexity.

19 Whispering Angel Provence Rosé			45
<i>Languedoc, France</i> An elegant whirl of peach and summer berries that's lined by zippy citrus and chased by a strawberry-soaked finish. If you drink this wine, you might hear them.			

20 Pasqua 11 Minutes Rosé	29
<i>Trevezie, Italy</i> This is an awesome alternative to Provence rose with it delicate red fruit flavours and hints of spice. A beautiful, intense and complex wine you are bound to love.	

21 San Giorgio Pinot Grigio Blush	6.6	8.5	23.9
<i>Venezie, Italy</i> Wonderfully light and delicate with crisp flavours of ripe summer berry fruit and well balanced acidity which lifts it all to perfect harmony.			

22 Gold County Zinfandel Rosé	6.1	7.8	21.9
<i>California, USA</i> This is a distinctly sweet style of rose with notes of rhubarb and custard sweets, parma violets and tutti frutti.
